

Questions to ask your doctor about secondary hyperparathyroidism and your treatment

Managing your health is a two-way relationship with your doctor and dialysis team to ensure you do what you can to maintain your health, and they do what they can to support you.

Below are some questions you can ask your doctor or dialysis care team to help you understand secondary hyperparathyroidism (sHPT) and any medications you are taking for it.

| 8 | How is my current treatment the best one for me? |
| 9 | What if I have challenges with my medication? |
